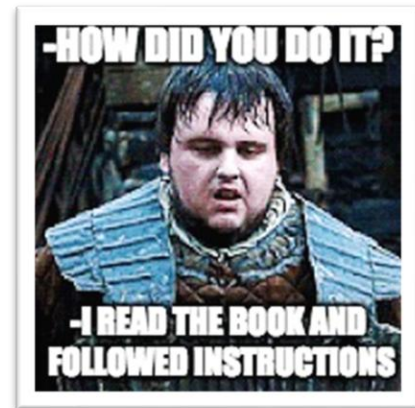

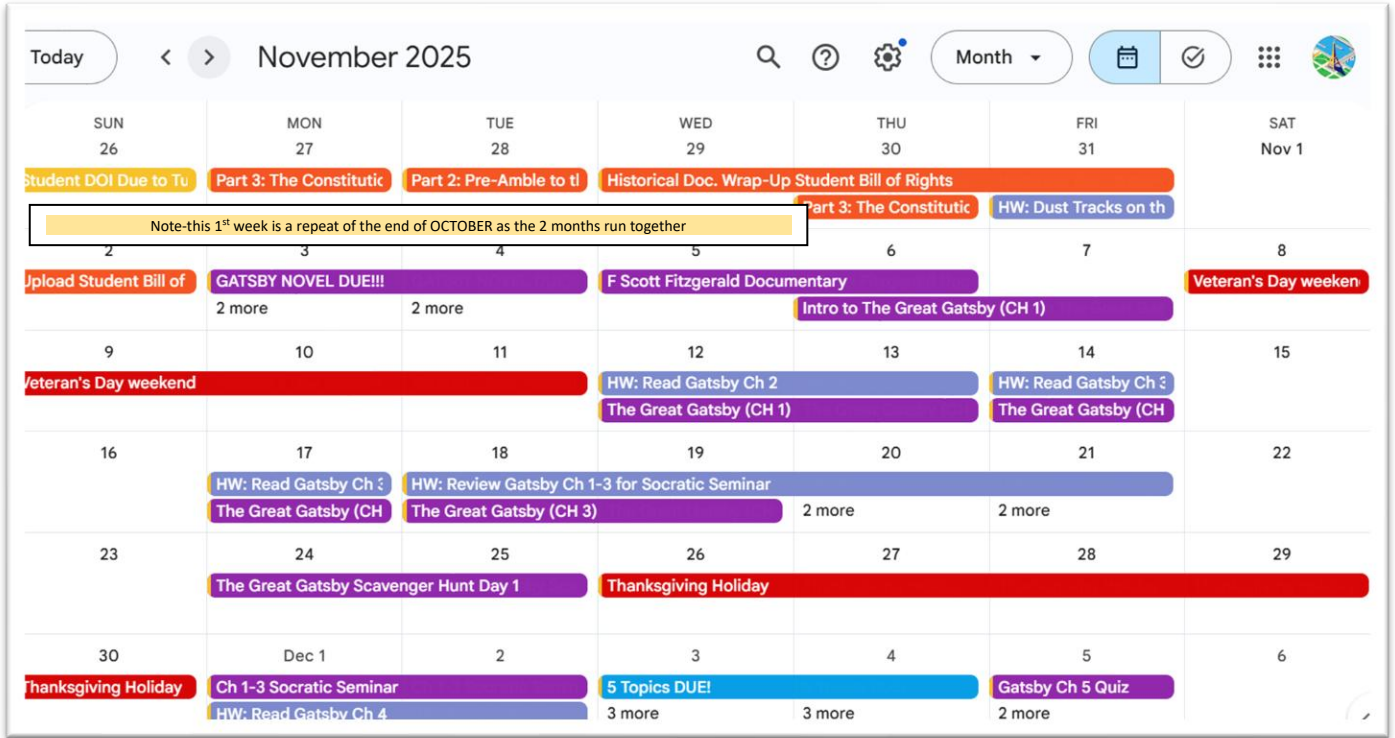

❖ **Novel Reading: *The Great Gatsby***

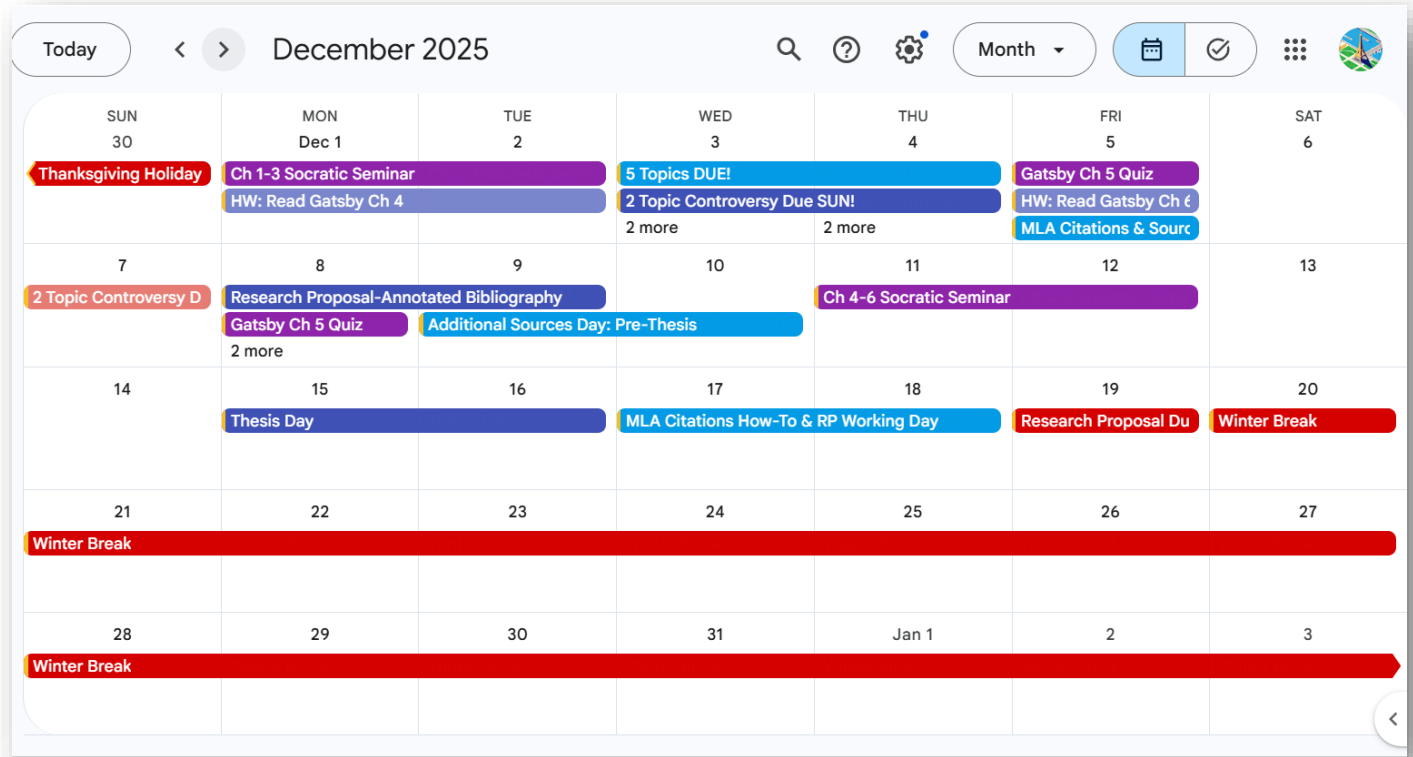
- **NIGHTLY READING** (students must have read the chapter to be prepared for in class assessments, analysis, & discussions!)
